

CHAPTER 1030

Solid and Infectious Wastes

EDITOR'S NOTE: Chapter 1030 was established by Resolution 190-77 adopted November 18, 1977. Under authority of ORC 3734.01 through 3734.99, the Summit County Board of Health administers and enforces those provisions of OAC 3745-27-01 through 3745-27-97 and OAC 3745-37-01 through 3745-37-15 pertaining to solid and infectious wastes. This responsibility includes plan approval, licensing, inspecting sites and facilities; and all other acts or efforts necessary to meet the requirements of solid and infectious waste disposal laws and regulations. The solid and infectious waste laws and regulations are published by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA), copies of which are available through the OEPA.

There are no sections in Chapter 1030. This chapter has been established to provide a place for cross references and any future legislation.
