

CHAPTER 1420

Food Service Operations

EDITOR'S NOTE: Chapter 1420 was replaced by Resolution 190-77 adopted November 18, 1977. Under authority of ORC 3717. 01 through 3717.99, the Summit County Board of Health administers and enforces OAC 3717-1-01 through 3717-1-20 (Food Safety Code) and OAC 3701-21-01 through 3701-21-26 (Administrative Rules) pertaining to food service operations, catering food service operations, food delivery sales operations, mobile food service operations, seasonal food service operations, temporary food service operations, and vending machine locations. This responsibility includes plan approval, licensing, inspecting, and all other acts or efforts necessary to assure compliance with the food service operations law and rules. The food service operations law and rules are published by the Ohio Department of Health, copies of which are available for distribution by the Summit County Board of Health.

There are no sections in Chapter 1420. This chapter has been established to provide a place for cross references and any future legislation.
